Our Vision

Our vision is to empower individuals to grow in their understanding of the Bible and build a strong foundation in Christian faith. By integrating theological training with practical outreach through sports ministry, we aim to nurture leaders who can serve society holistically—spiritually, physically, and socially. This program aspires to create lasting impact in communities by fostering unity, hope, and transformation through the teachings of Christ.

Project Context

Kenya, with a population exceeding 54 million, is predominantly Christian, yet faces significant challenges. While 80% of the population identifies as Christian, the rise of the prosperity gospel has distorted the true essence of the faith. Coupled with widespread poverty, these challenges highlight the urgent need for initiatives that restore biblical integrity and address practical societal needs. Our project responds to this context, offering a balanced approach to spiritual and community development.



Looking back on 2024:

In 2024, the Word of Life Kenya Bible School, in collaboration with partners such as SRS International, The Main Thing Kenya, and Kick off to Hope, successfully executed a 13–14-week program at Word of Life Ukunda in Kwale County, Kenya. This initiative provided students with theological training and practical experience in sports ministry, equipping them to serve their communities holistically. The program's success was attributed to meticulous planning and the combined efforts of all stakeholders, culminating in a meaningful impact on both participants and the local community.
